**August 1, 2017 (Columbus, Ind.)** – Please take notice that the Columbus Indiana Philharmonic has changed the venue for the upcoming season opening concert on Saturday, September 16, 2017 to:

The opening concert is scheduled for Saturday, September 16, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. with pianist Tony DeSare. The change of venue is necessary following a 3-week delay in the auditorium renovation project at Columbus North High School.

Due to differing auditorium seat numbering arrangements, the Philharmonic will divide Robbins Auditorium seating into four zones that best compare to the zone arrangements at Erne Auditorium.
