SATURDAY, MARCH 27, 2021

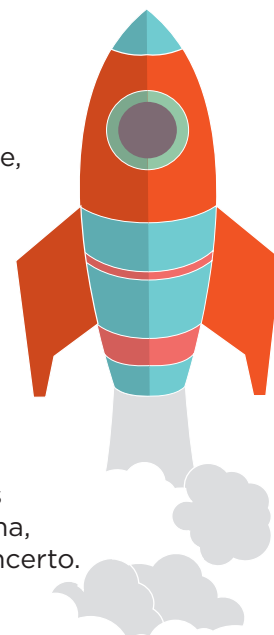
