Pursuant to IC4-32.3-5-5(b), your organization must open and maintain one separate and segregated checking account for charity gaming purposes. Proceeds from all charity gaming activities must be deposited into this single account. All expenses related to the charity gaming activity as well as any other allowable expenses must be paid for by check or debit card from this account.

Remember, all licensed supplies, devices or equipment must be purchased from a distributor licensed by the Indiana Gaming Commission. A list of licensed distributors is available on our website under "Licensed Manufacturer and Distributors".
