Compensation is as follows:

• Concertmaster - \$148 per service/approx. 36 services

- Associate Concertmaster \$92 per service/approx. 36 services
- Assistant Principal 2nd Violin \$81 per service/approx. 36 services
- Section Violin \$81 per service/ approx. 36 services

Travel compensation for the 23/24 CIP season is \$.38 per mile for a max of \$55 per round trip.

Applications should be submitted by Wednesday, August 16th, 2023 by end of day.

Applicants will be pre-screened based on resume, and may or may not be invited to a live audition. All applicants will play behind a screen for all rounds.

Candidates auditioning for the Concertmaster, Associate Concertmaster, and Assistant Principal 2nd Violin positions who are not awarded these positions may be offered section contracts.

Any candidate not offered a position may be added to the sub list.

All applicants should prepare the following:

Solo Repertoire

Exposition of the first movement from a concerto from the standard repertoire not by Mozart

AND

Exposition of the first movement from Mozart Concerto No. 3, 4, or 5 (K. 216, 218, or 219)

AND

J.S. Bach: Any one movement from an unaccompanied Sonata or Partita
